Q: What is our goal with Kingdom Builders?

A: To give to global missions, local church outreach, and future Christian leaders in a way that New Life has never thought possible.

"Make Disciples of all Nations"

New Life is a sending and supporting church. We believe that it is our calling to go, and to provide resources for those who go for us.

10 RED ZONE MISSIONARIES

\$70,000

PRIORITY ONE

\$60,000

Our "Red Zone" missionaries work in what is known as the 10/40 Window. Located between 10 degrees and 40 degrees north of the equator, these nations contain 2/3rds of the world's population, 82% of the poorest and poverty-stricken, and have some of the highest resistance to missions and Christian faith. It's not enough to take the Gospel across the world. New leaders must be trained and equipped to pastor the new churches that are planted. New Life is partnering with Priority One to build a Bible college in Tanzania that will allow the churches in Africa to grow and thrive.

60 PARTNERING MISSIONARIES \$145,000

New Life partners with and supports 60 missionaries around the world. If God calls people to missions, we are committed to sending them. Missionaries are the front line of the Gospel and the boots on the ground throughout the globe. Our missionaries rely on our monthly support as well as funding for special projects and resources.

MISSIONARY CARE TEAM

\$25,000

New Life provides tangible care for missionaries outside of their living expenses. We provide airfare for emergency travel, scholarships for children's college, appliance replacement, unique needs, etc.



NEW LIFE MISSIONARY, BERT FIELDS \$25,000

New Life has its own missionary couple who leads construction mission trips all over the world. For the last 30 years, they have taken teams to build churches, Bible schools, and homes. Bert and Linda are volunteers, and New Life covers their travel expenses.

MEXICO HOMES

\$30,000

Every Memorial Day weekend, New Life commits to traveling to Mexico and help build homes in the community. During the pandemic in 2021 our team built a home for a family, provided groceries, and support. This year the goal is to build four homes in one weekend! It is amazing to see our teams go above and beyond in this region!

March 4-19, 2023

For this trip, we will be working on a building that will be manufacturing tabernacles in Mozambique. The missionaries there are Toby and Melinda Magill. This project is just outside of Maputo, the capital of Mozambique. We will be spending a week there and then a couple of days in Kruger Park and then off to Cape Town. We will be working on a new church plant in the Woodstock area of Cape Town, headed up by missionaries Scott and Erin Pongrats.

GLOBAL BUILDING PROJECTS

\$75,000

Providing homes for the needy and houses of worship for new congregations worldwide is a Kingdom Builders' priority. Providing a church building and food/COVID relief packs for a church plant deep in the Amazon is an example of meeting critical needs among unreached peoples. We partner with YWAM in Mexico to build homes for the homeless. Another major endeavor is raising steel-framed tabernacles for newly established congregations in places like Mozambique, South Africa, India, and Cuba.

CONVOY OF HOPE DISASTER RELIEF \$100,000

Convoy of Hope is an international relief and aid organization. They respond to natural disasters and work to bring hope to children and families around the world. In addition to disaster relief, Convoy provides ongoing food programs for impoverished kids, economic empowerment programs for women, education, and other resources. convoyofhope.org

CONVOY OF HOPE FEED ONE

\$15,000 (Support a Child For \$10/Month)

One Day to Feed the World is Convoy of Hope's campaign that transforms lives. When New Life commits to giving \$10/ month, we harness the power of equal sacrifice instead of focusing on equal giving. When you give through Convoy of Hope, poverty and hunger are replaced by hope and love. "Pastoring the Pacific Northwest"

New Life currently spans across four locations in South King County. Each of these cities has unique needs and challenges that our church is called to face. We are not content to enjoy the blessings God has given us, but instead, we are committed to seeing the hurting, the suffering, and the disenfranchised of our communities know and experience not only the truth of the Gospel but tangible, real-life expressions of God's love.





NORMANDY PARK CAMPUS

\$20,000

The story of our Burien location now re-opening in Normandy Park is a real miracle. It doesn't happen without an investment of people, time, and money. We can help with all three, but this is our chance to specifically invest dollars in the beginnings of something that will have a Kingdom impact on individual lives and the communities of Normandy Park and Burien.

CHURCH PLANTING

\$15,000

Jesus said, "I will build my church," and he's called us to join that effort by making disciples of all nations. The Church Planting Fund allows us to follow Jesus as he leads us to open a new campus, respond to new opportunities, or underwrite a church plant until it reaches financial self-sustainability.

MAPLE VALLEY/COVINGTON CAMPUS

\$120,000

Beginning as a dream nearly two years ago, building a brand new facility on our Covington property to house the growing New Life Maple Valley/ Covington Campus is becoming a reality. The merger of New Life and Solid Rock Community Church gave both church families the ability to do together what neither could do independently. Build Now is our new initiative to complete the project by Fall 2023..



Over the past two years New Life has the unique opportunity in providing assistance to many hurting people. We responded to the challenge of delivering essential supplies and donations of all kinds, volunteers that provided assistance to our campuses and other churches in our communities by distributing truck loads of goods to the surrounding areas.

The heart of New Life is to care for those in need in whatever capacity we can help. The Benevolence Fund provides the resources to meet these needs as they arise.

VINE MAPLE PLACE

\$60,000

Vine Maple Place aims to end homelessness in South King County. In 2021 New Life Church partnered with Vine Maple Place to help single parents and children become safe, stable and self-sufficient by opening a New Hope Center in our former Kent Campus. Together we will help 1000 families over the next two years.
