



Theology Threads | Episode 4 Notes | God Made It

Summary

In Episode 4 of Theology Threads, titled God Made It, Dr. Brian Jenkins and Pastor Miles Langrock continue to build upon the previous episodes discussion about what Christians really believe. They introduce the first of the four pillars of Christianity, God Made It. Brian and Miles discuss the Apostles Creed, the metaphor of God as the Creator, why God put us here, and more. You can watch Episode 3 to introduce the topic of what Christians really believe and watch Episode 5 as it releases to continue to learn about the core pillars of the Christian faith.

Reflection Questions

Brian uses the following view of God as the starting point for this episode, "God is the loving and benevolent creator and sustain of all things, seen and unseen, crafting them alone and through His will." How was your initial view of God similar or different? Does this statement change the way you think about God?

How does looking at the world through the God Made It lens challenge you? Do you find yourself thinking about the people around you differently? Does it change how you think about yourself?

If you could share one concept or point addressed in Episode 4, what would it be? Who would you share it with?
